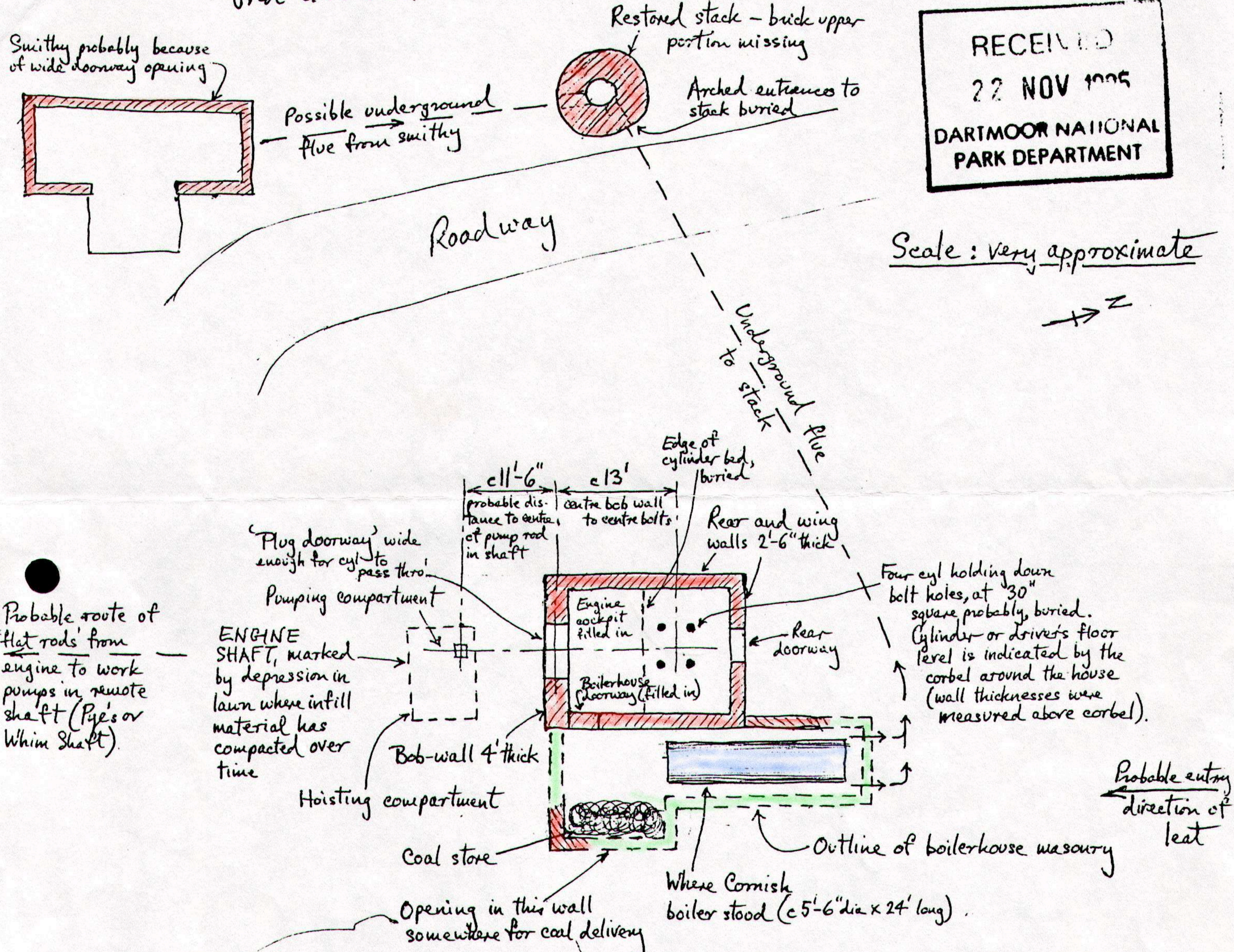


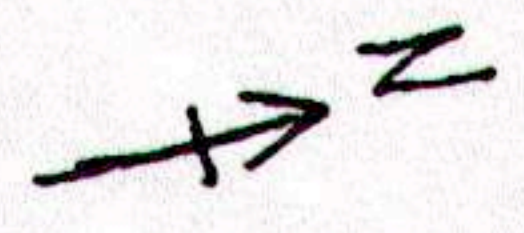
Birds Aller Silver-lead Mine, South Devon

This area is probably the flattened waste tip.

Site interpretation by Kenneth Brown

Key - Surviving masonry
 - Absent or buried masonry

Notes The sites of the horse whim, shaft capstan (manual) and balance pit are not identifiable.

The site owner is Mr Steer of 'Manny Waters'.

A 30-inch, 8 ft stroke Cornish pump engine, an 8 ton boiler, a 30 ft of waterwheel and other materials were advertised for sale 'Mining Journal' 2nd Jan 1855. Query - did the waterwheel hoist from the two shafts?
