

Dinas Ddu Quarry SH594453

Description: ++ Small hillside quarry with some underground workings, having a small tramway network and a water powered mill. Output carted to Porthmadog. Little activity after about 1870.

Remains: A dwelling occupies what was possibly the site of an office. The mill with its wheel pit has been used as a source of stone for nearby farm structures. A nice stone cutting leads to the working area. The adit is open for a short distance. There is some leatwork. ++
