


Tourists about to Descend the Incline.

THE SCENIC RAILWAY

By the co-operation of Katoomba Colliery Limited, the convenience and the enjoyment of visitors is being splendidly catered for. Were it not that the Scenic Railway is made available for the use of the public at night, the vantage point from which what is considered by many to be the best obtainable view of Katoomba Falls, would be inaccessible. This view of Katoomba Falls, obtained from the vicinity of York Cave by daylight, may be deserving of all that is claimed

for it; but the beauty that is unfolded at night when the Falls are floodlit by projectors from the Mine section of the lighting eclipses all daylight effects. Then, too, the manner in which the fern glades and the grottoes, the rock clefts and the overhanging projections, the miniature waterfalls and the sparkling streamlets, visible along the route from the Railway to York Cave, are made more entrancing by the artistic arrangement of appropriate floodlighting, leaves little to be
