All demonstrations and talks will last for about 15 minutes – except where stated. There may be the chance to ask the demonstrators questions at the end of each show.

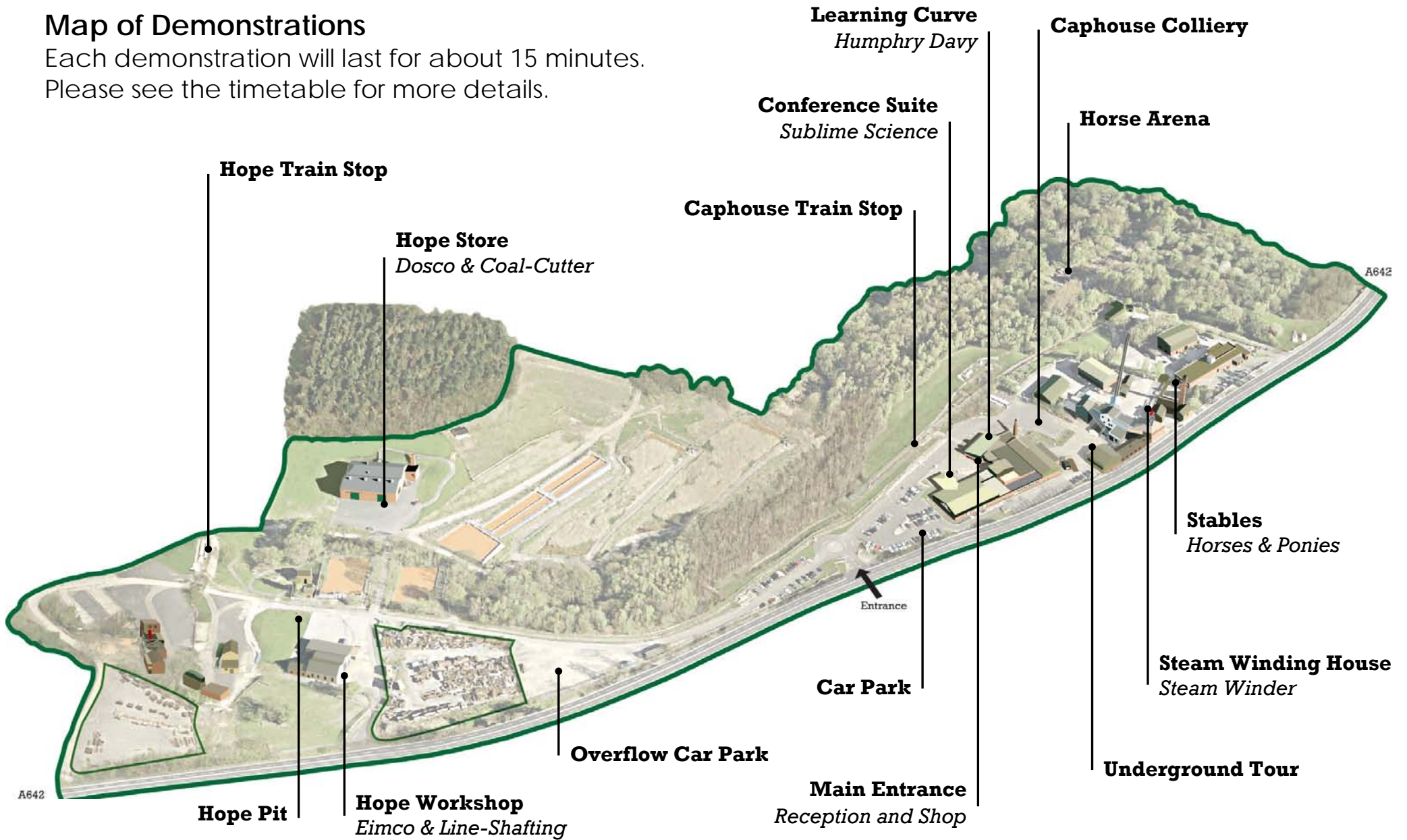
